



Using FAEIS Data in a NIFA Priority Area Obesity Disciplines

Searching the 2010 CIP codes for "Obesity" gives one result:
60.0516 Endocrinology, Diabetes and Metabolism Residency Program.

A residency training program that prepares physicians to specialize in disorders of the internal (endocrine) glands such as the thyroid and adrenal glands, and to deal with disorders such as diabetes, metabolic and nutritional disorders, obesity, pituitary diseases, and menstrual and sexual problems. *Requires prior completion of a program in internal medicine.*
